19th SG meeting: Conclusions

Many topics, selected conclusions:

□ AD HOC WP on projects:

- List of projects list:
 - updated list of projects sent to PACs by most of macro-region countries,
- ✓ Conclusions:
- a) PA1b **project form** to be upgraded;
- b) The **Alpine-Western Balkan multimodal corridor** to be included to TEN-T core network during the TEN-T revision
- The issue of much too long planning processes (EIA, feasibility studies, planning documents) that often are measured in tenth years before construction works can start
- ✓ Conclusion: PA1b can:
 - a) PAC-s explore possibility to organise a Workshop on this topic or
 - b) to **initiate a study** in order to compile the best practices.







19th SG meeting: Conclusions (2)

☐ SG MEETING:

PA1b priority topics:

Conclusion: Preliminary suggested topics are to be rethinked and confirmed or modified by next meeting. Attention is to be paid to topics that contribute to cohesion and narrowing gaps between the countries or parts of the macro-region.

Cross-border issues:

Conclusion: Although many decision-makers and experts are trying to find the best solutions for years, in practice there are almost no progress in terms of shortening the time needed to cross the border by truck or train. Nevertheless, we need to continue looking for practical solutions.

■ EUSDR – EUSAIR cooperation:

Conclusion: While cooperation between two MRS exists, it is noted that mutual cooperation can be strengthen in future.
