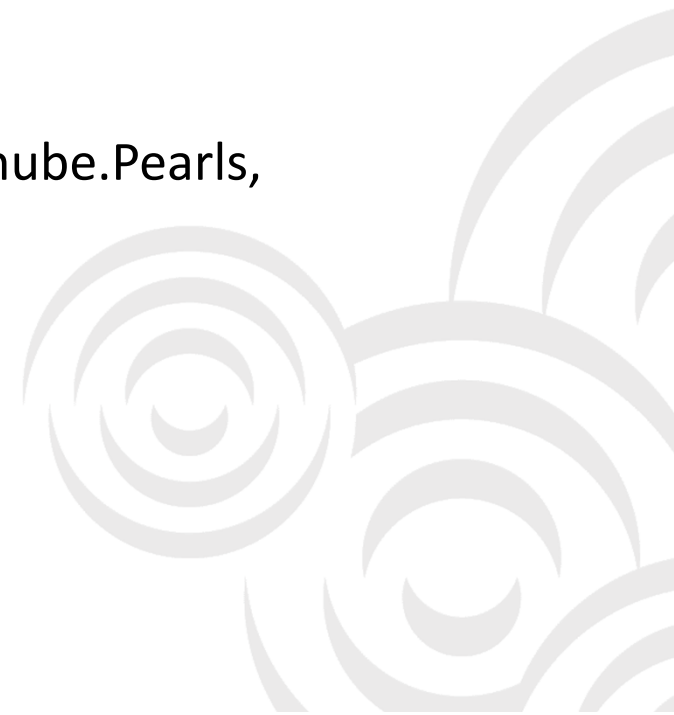

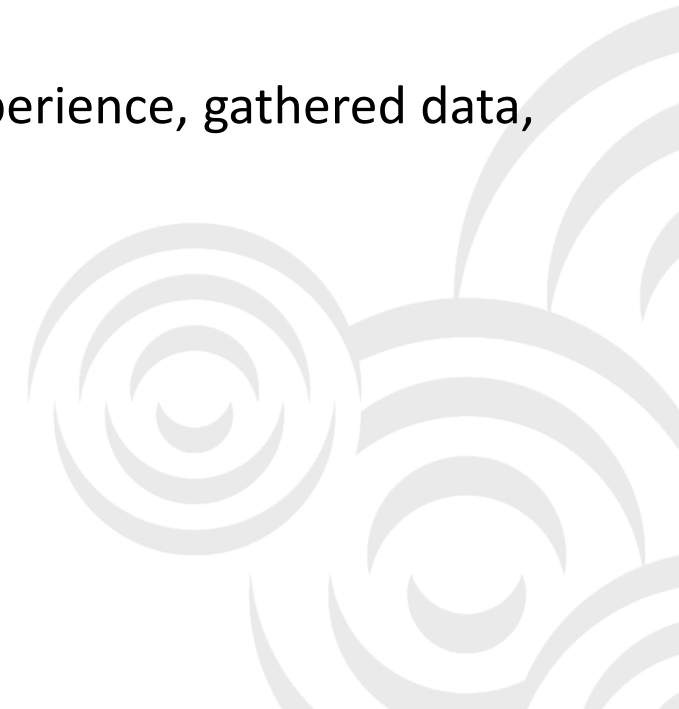




## Sustainable Transport Systems and Mobility Capitalization DtP Pole in action
