WBIF December 2009 – to date

- Blending mechanism to expedite priority investments in key socioeconomic sectors in the Western Balkans
- By July 2013, 9 calls for proposals have resulted in 160 grants worth €289 million approved for some 140 projects in transport, energy, environment, social sector and private sector development
- Total estimated investment value of all projects is €10.7 billion, estimated loans €4.8 billion of which €3 billion are signed
- All major IFIs active in the Balkans are involved as well as bilateral donors – EU and non EU





WBIF - Transport Sector


- 34 grants approved worth €53.5 million of which 28 for grants preparing loans while for 5 grants loan agreements already in place
- IFIs are financing for the 5 projects already under construction which having loans value of €1.28 billion while project investments for these projects totals for €2.4 billion






Overview of WBIF pipeline – Transport sector

34 projects supported by WBIF in Transport sector (by Round 9, July 2013) With total amount of grants € 53.3 million






Investment value for WBIF infrastructure grants [€ billions]






Distribution of the WBIF Transport sector projects per sub-sectors

WBIF - Latest Call for Proposals – Round 10

- 22 applications for grants received
- 4 for transport investments (2 from Serbia and 2 from Montenegro)
- Screening of applications has commenced.
- Projects that pass screening and assessment will be considered by PFG in November and recommendations will be made to Steering Committee
