

The VNR Process:

Establishing the whole-of government approach, breaking siloes, and building partnerships

Coordination mechanism

- Focal point for the 2030 Agenda = **Gov. Office for Development and European Cohesion Policy**
- **The Permanent Inter-Ministerial Working group on Development Policies** established in the beginning of 2017



Integrated Approach

- Regular briefings at the governmental sessions by the Minister for Development and the Minister for Foreign Affairs
- 2030 Agenda calls for action both home and in the international community
- The final report of the VNR has been adopted by the Government

Creating Ownership

- Gap analysis of all the policies and measurements that Slovenia already has in place and that are contributing to the SDG and their targets.

Building partnerships

- Need for a more comprehensive approach to dialogue with civil society
