TECHNICAL VISIT

Ljubljana / Slovenia**

9.00	Shuttle transfer to Ljubljana centre: meeting point in front of Austria Trend Hotel, Ljubljana (those staying at the hotel)
9.15 – 11.15	Meeting point: Miklosiceva ulica – by Fontaine (30 m from Grand Hotel Union)
9.15 – 11.15	Ljubljana: European Green Capital 2016 Ljubljana - awarded a prestigious title European Green Capital 2016 – is small by surface area, but huge in terms of hospitality and quality of life. Numerous infrastructure changes for the better, replaced the busy traffic in the city in just a decade. A guided visit will explore what makes Ljubljana a green capital in terms of: green transport, air, water, public green surfaces and other responsible and environmentally friendly solutions.
11.15 – 11.45	Transfer to Dragomelj
11.45 – 12.35	The DARS Control Centre (at Dragomelj) Guided tour of the Traffic Information Centre for motorways. A guided visit will show way of monitoring traffic on Slovenian motorways.
12.35 – 13.00	Transfer to Brnik
13.00 – 14.00	Slovenia Control Ltd. (Air Traffic Control Centre at the Ljubljana Airport) Guided tour at the premises of Slovenia Control will enable participants to get insight into the work of controllers of the civil aviation. The Slovenia Control centre is situated in a newly built and newly equipped building and provides air traffic control and management in all phases of flight and traffic flow at airports in a safe, high-quality and efficient manner.
14.15 – 16.00	Lunch and end of the guided visits, transfer to the airport/hotel
