
Transport networks capacity assessment

Road	 47% is in no need of immediate intervention by 2030 33% in need of immediate maintenance/rehabilitation 20% needs to be upgrade/widening by 2030 		
Railway	 48% is in no need of immediate intervention by 2030 19% in need of immediate maintenance/rehabilitation 33% needs to be upgraded by 2030 		
Airports	Adequate to meet the demand by 2030		
IWW ports	rts • IWW ports requires expansion by 2030		
Maritime ports	Increase the capacity to handle passenger transport and Port of Durres for freight flows too



- > Railway market open for domestic carries
 - ✓ In Albania, Kosovo*, Montenegro, Serbia



- Road safety inspections, ITS deployment, Road/rail maintenance and road border crossing facilitation
 - ✓ Connecta TA completed in 2018
- National Connectivity Reform Measures
 - ✓ Joint operation in Tuzi between Albania and Montenegro operational
 - ✓ Merdare new CCP operational

Commitments and challenges ahead

- Transport Community structures to be established as a legal successor of SEETO
- Continued commitment towards development of multimodal Core/Comprehensive Network
- Regional Participants to work together towards the aligning of the transport system with the EU, for enabling market rules and EU standards
- Full ownership of Connecta TA needs to be materialized by the RPs. Further assistance is needed in order to achieve some of 2020 targets.
