DSP supported the EUSDR HR PCY in organising an online NC meeting (05/2020). PACs were supported in organising their online SG meetings (05 & 06/2020). The DSP has provided the tools (Zoom & WebEx) for these tasks.

Needs Assessment



Based on the EUSDR Operational Evaluation (07/2019) the DSP elaborated a Needs Assessment for closer cooperation in SGs to enhance the participation of the different stakeholder groups of the memberstates (to be published). Streamlined communication



DSP is the coordinating and connecting structure between countries & key implementers of the EUSDR acting as a communication hub. DSP supported the EUSDR HR PCY in preparing a Governance Paper and the Rules of Procedures for NCs.

MRS support



DSP provides on a regular basis information about MRS (NC/PAC meetings). DSP supported the EUSDR HR PCY in establishing a MRS TRIO PCY network and promoted the 1st MRS Week of the EC (02/2020). In addition DSP is member of the INTERACT Working Group on common capacity building support environment for MRS as well es other Working Groups managed by Interact.

- → NCs as target groups for strategic decision making












EUSDR website
