CINEA in a nutshell



~ 58 billion for the period 2021-2027





from 2800+ projects managed in October 2021 to > 4500 projects in 2027

- Policy feedback as an essential part of funding activities
- Expertise at the service of beneficiaries in managing the complete lifecycle of projects
- Exploitation of synergies and dynamic ways to work across programmes



CINEA's key contribution to EU Green Deal



- investing in environmentally-friendly technologies and infrastructure
- supporting industry to innovate
- rolling out cleaner, cheaper and healthier forms of private and public transport
- decarbonising the energy sector
- ensuring that buildings are more energy efficient

CEF policy objectives



- Contribute to the objectives of the Green Deal and the Sustainable and Smart Mobility Strategy
- Contribute to the development of the TEN-T, including adaptation of parts of it for the civilian-defence dual use
- At least 60% of the financial envelope will be dedicated to the Union's climate targets



Climate tracking

Climate tracking of CEF expenditures done by topic – methodology consistent with other EU programmes – no action required from applicants

Climate proofing

- Proofing of climate impact mitigation and adaptation is required for all projects subject to an IEA
- It is recommended to use the Technical Guidance on the climate proofing of infrastructure in the period 2021-2027 (Official Journal of the European Union, C 373, 16 September 2021)



Mitigation measures

- Activities relating to the mitigation of environmental impact and the preservation of biodiversity are eligible
- > Examples: reforestation, ecoducts, noise protection barriers...

Synergetic elements

- Energy or digital investments (beyond what is covered in the calls) are eligible within a limit of 20% of the eligible costs and provided they improve the socio-economic, climate or environmental benefits of the project.
- Example: on-site renewable energy generation



CEF <u>transport work programme</u> 2021-2023 € 18,2 billion

Frontloading: 70% of the CEF budget to be allocated in the period 2021-2023 through →

- ➤ 3 calls for proposals of € 5.5 billion each in 2021, 2022 and 2023
- A 3-year rolling call for the Alternative Fuel Infrastructure Facility of € 1.5 billion (5 deadlines, every 6 months)
- ➤ € 200 million for technical assistance actions

Just Transition Mechanism

to support and finance regions most exposed to transition challenges in all Member States



The JTM includes a governance framework centered on territorial just transition plans **Total Budget of € 1,5 bn managed by CINEA**



Main features of the public sector loan facility

- **Nature:** Blending facility combining:
 - *Grants*: EUR 1.525 billion from Union resources; and
 - Loans: EUR 10 billion from EIB resources
- **Objective:** addresses development needs of the territories most affected by the climate transition
- **Beneficiaries:** Public sector entities
- Access to the facility: through open call for proposals, first call (with national allocations) launch in 2022 provided that a sufficient number of TJTPs are adopted
- **Budget allocation:** National shares until December 2025 (according to JTF allocation)
- **Management:** Direct management of the grants (delegated to CINEA)
- Advisory support: EUR 35 million available for advisory support including 10 million for administrative capacity of beneficiary (notably in less developed regions)

IF Small Scale Maritime Transport Project



FirstBio2Shipping – Starting on 01/01/2022

FirstBio2Shipping project will develop the first industrial plant converting biogas to renewable, low-carbon bio-liquefied natural gas (bio-LNG) in a standardised and scalable fashion, with minimal waste and energy usage. The bio-LNG will be delivered to the marine industry, enabling the cost-effective substitution of heavy fuel oil (HFO).

GREENMOTRIL – Starting date 01/01/2022

The GREENMOTRIL project will transform the large seaport of Motril (ES) into the first European port able to operate completely off-grid, based on a self-managed energy community which uses renewable energy and storage technologies and can intelligently manage power demand using advanced technologies.
